It goes without saying that this off season has had its fill of trials and tribulations starting before OTR 2018 even ended. But we're not here to dwell in the past — however, this year's theme of the '70's does give pause to reflect on how far things have come. TRA has already agreed to step up with initial funding but we still need everyone's help to realize our dream of making your sauna area into the world class, one of a kind facility it should be. There are already 2 very generous anonymous benefactors that have agreed to match dollar for dollar everything we fund raise up to \$10,000 until the end of OTR ... every dollar pledged becomes three dollars towards the
